

Free Surgical Eye Camp at Mahuva, Dist. Bhavnagar, Gujarat by Vision Foundation of India



A free surgical eye camp was held from 20th June to 24th June 2015 at Mahuva, District Bhavnagar, Gujarat by a team of doctors from Vision Foundation of India, Mumbai. Shri Muraribapu blessed and inaugurated the free surgical eye camp by lighting of the lamp.

In his address, he commended the social cause of eradication of blindness taken up by Dr. Kulin Kothari and his team of Vision Foundation of India and helping the poor to get the best of eye care at free of cost. Free eye screening was carried out on 20th and 21st June 2015 held at Hanumant School run by Shri Rashes & Rupal Kanakia of Kanakia Spaces Ltd., Mumbai.

Free cataract surgeries were performed at Hanumant Hospital by Dr. Kulin Kothari, Dr. Saumil Kothari and the team from Vision Foundation of India, Mumbai from 22nd to 24th June 2015



In spite of rains and unfriendly weather, the eye camp had tremendous response from nearby towns and villages. 1000 patients were screened for Cataract and other eye disorders. 117 patients have been operated for Cataract at Hanumant Hospital, Mahuva. Patients with other eye disorders were given free medicines.

The post-operative care is being performed by Dr. Rashmi Sharma of Hanumant Hospital. She is trained by Dr. Kulin Kothari at Bombay City Eye Institute & Research Centre, Mumbai.

The free surgical camp was held under Vision Foundation of India's "**Rashtriya Netra Yagna**", where more than 1 million free surgeries will be carried out across India. It is estimated to reduce the avoidable blindness by around 6% to 8% in India.
